### **SECRETARY GENERAL'S REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2015**

Mr. President, Trustees, Members of the Sri Lanka National Trust Ladies and Gentlemen.

I am pleased to present the Annual Report of the National Trust for the 11<sup>th</sup> consecutive year as its Secretary General from its inception in May 2005 and to report that we could see a steady growth during this period and particularly in the year under review (2015/2016). During the year the general membership has increased from 340 to 551 and the Life Members from 148 to 171, majority of whom are academics and professionals. I have attached the lists of the membership to the report already circulated, for your information. I am not going to read them all in order to save time for our monthly lecture scheduled after this AGM.

The year 2015 also saw the successful implementation of a variety of heritage based activities which benefited its members in particular and the public in general. Conducting of a series of special lectures monthly by selected scholars and specialists, arranging opportunities for the membership and their invitees to join its Quarterly Heritage Tours, conducting regular monthly progress review meetings of the Trustees, Management Committee and Scientific sub-committees of heritage specialists, publication of books on heritage subjects and assisting writers and authors on natural and cultural heritage subjects , conducting heritage related special training and familiarization projects in association with national and international heritage organizations and maintaining a website to share its experience and knowledge with the public here and abroad, are some of the heritage based activities implemented during the year. Through many of these activities, the National Trust arranged opportunities for its members to meet most of their fellow members in order to maintain a good relationship and share their knowledge on Sri Lanka's heritage among all members of the society.

It is important to highlight here the monthly special lecture series, as one of the major activities which brought the membership together and kept the National Trust alive throughout the year . In addition to the educational and academic value, the special monthly lectures brought much publicity to the National Trust and became a source of encouragement to both the membership drive and its fund raising efforts. Of the 81 **special** lecture series **11** presentations were held during the period under review (2015/2016). These lectures were presented by recognized scholars and professionals in their respective fields and were well attended. The results have been gratifying as shown by the response of the scholars who delivered the lectures in an honorary capacity and the enthusiasm of the participants. Please see **Annexure I** for the details of the 11 lectures and the presenters.

Today after the AGM we will be listening to our  $82^{nd}$  special lecture titled, "An Astronomical view of the Buddha's Visit to Sri Lanka" by Dr. Kavan Ratnatunge. On behalf of the Trustees and the general membership may I extend our gratitude to all of them.

Quarterly Heritage Tours, another popular activity of the NT gave the members an opportunity to meet in smaller groups when they joined the tours which were well organized and guided by eminent personalities in the subject of heritage. Four Quarterly Heritage Tours were conducted during the year under review, enabling members who participated to gather knowledge about a number of lesser known heritage sites in the country. As a practice, separate Tour Guide booklets were published during the tours for the benefit of both the participating and non-participating members. The latest tour which was conducted at the beginning of this month gave the participants a new experience to visit more than 10 important heritage sites Buttala, Wellawaya and Monaragala area in two days including an overnight stay.

The National Trust continued its practice and tradition of conducting regular monthly **Progress Review Meetings of the Trustees** and **Meetings of the Management Committee throughout** the year in 2015/16 without any interruption. The **116<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Trustees** was conducted just an hour ago to work out the policies, plans and strategies to be implemented by the TRUT and to review the progress of projected and planned activities. Twelve meetings were held during the year under review.

The Management Committee, one of the main driving forces behind the success of affairs of the Trust conducted 11 meetings during the year by playing a key role in the running of the Trust and by working out every minute detail of the programmes of activities covering all aspects, paying special attention to fundraising, effective management of finances, the membership drive and the policy frame work in relation to day to day operations. On behalf of the general membership, let me take this opportunity to extend our gratitude, to the members of the Management Committee namely, Prof. Nimal de Silva, Dr. Roland Silva. Mr. U.L.Kadurugamuwa, Mr. K. Kanag-Isvaran and Mr. N.G. Wickremeratne for working with much dedication throughout the year along with the representatives of the HNB Sustainability Foundation, Mr Nawaz Bin Sadoon, Ms. Tara Wickremanake and Mrs. Virginia Fernando of the National Trust office and Major General (Rtd) Lohan Goonewardena of M/s F. J &.G de Sarams and other volunteers who supported the committee to reach the present level of success. The new Trustees Ms. Ayomi Aluvihare and Mr. Nissanka Weerasekere have been appointed to be members of the Management Committee effective from January 2016. I also wish to announce that Mrs. Virginia Fernando has taken over the responsibility of the NT office from Ms. Tara Wickremanayake. Mr. Sandoon has indicated his intention to continue to be associated with the activities of the Trust like Ms. Devika Anthonis did before. We record here with much appreciation their dedicated service and the duties already accomplished and the readiness to continue with us.

Scientific Sub-Committees which are comprised of professionals and outstanding persons in the relevant areas of heritage studies and their monthly meetings covered the academic aspects of heritage. They extended support to the main body to implement activities belonging to the respective specialized areas of heritage. Their professional input has been of much importance to the activities of the Trust. The 8 Scientific Sub-Committees which assisted the Trust to achieve results in the respective specialized heritage subjects were Monuments and Sites, Moveable Artefacts, Natural Heritage, Intangible Heritage, Paintings, Sculpture and Visual Arts, Architectural Conservation, Cultural Routes and Industrial Heritage. During the year under review the eight sub-committees conducted regular monthly meetings and discussions to formulate and carryout plans. The programmes implemented by them were of immense importance to the Trust and to the heritage of the nation at large. During 2015 also some of the sub-committees helped to publish their work in the form of research material and books to supplement the special publication series, while others conducted workshops and seminars of heritage importance for members and the general public. We thank Dr. Roland Silva, the Past President, Prof. Nimal De Silva, members of the sub-committees and the Chairpersons for encouraging and assisting the sub-committees. Our special thanks to Mr. Prasad Fonseka for serving voluntarily as the secretary to the sub-committees and co-ordinating the meetings with Dr. Nilan Cooray.

As another major activity, publication of a series of special volumes on Cultural and Natural Heritage and publication of another set of volumes on Outstanding International and National Artists of Sri Lanka continued in 2015 as well. Of the total of the first series, nine volumes are out and two of them namely, "The Art of making Masks in Sri Lanka" and "Grown in Sri Lanka: Cultivated Flowering Plants" were launched during the year under review. In addition to the above some other general books on the subject of heritage were prepared during the 2015 and arrangements are underway to publish them during 2016. Please see Annexure II for details of the full lists of volumes. In addition to dissemination of knowledge among the public on Sri Lanka's heritage, the publication project supported the National Trust as a mean of raising funds. On behalf of the Trustees and the general membership I take this opportunity to extend the gratitude of the Trust to the authors, the designer and the copy editor for devoting their valuable time in writing, designing and editing these handsome volumes and so making their contribution to the nation. The National Trust also wishes to thank the sponsors who contributed funds to meet the cost of printing, thus extending their generosity to promote the cultural traditions of our country and the trustees who took the initiative to find suitable sponsors towards this worthy project.

The National Trust was successful in reaching its fund raising targets in the year 2015. Due to its various fund raising efforts, the Trust collected an income of Rs 3,727,716 by the end of 2015 providing sufficient funds to run its day to day activities. Total spending has been Rs.2, 565,776. Please refer to the Audited Statement of Accounts already made available to you for details. However we still need sponsors for the special publications programme .We take this opportunity to thank the Management Committee, specially Mr. N.G.Wickremeratne, for their guidance in more effective management and control of its income and expenditure. Also our very special thanks to M/s Ernst and Young for auditing of accounts in an honorary capacity. The

sources of funding have been local and international donors, sponsors, well-wishers, sale of publications and the general membership fees. The Hatton National Bank continued to contribute generously to meet the day to day expenditure of the Trust during 2015 as well and pledged their support for the year 2016. We thank the Directors of Hatton National Bank for this generous grant.

As a policy, the Trust extended its support and consultancy services to outside organizations free of charge and continued to assist other institutions and individuals in dealing with the subject of the preservation of heritage and in promoting international cooperation on heritage activities during the year. As it was practiced in the previous years, the National Trust continued to be associated with the extraordinary work of collaboration with public and private sector national and international institutions such as The Department of Archaeology, Central Cultural Fund, Department National Museums, Urban Development Authority, Colombo Municipality and the National Physical Planning Department on various heritage projects. The international institutions associated with the National Trust were the International National Trust Organization (INTO), the Dutch-Sri Lanka Association and the Centre for International Heritage Activities (CIE), IIAS, IHS and RCE in the Netherlands. Two major Heritage Training projects were initiated with the IIAS, IHS and RCE in the Netherlands to train middle level professionals of Sri Lankan heritage institutions such as the UDA, Department Archaeology and the CCF in September and October 2015 in Trincomalee and Kandy respectively. "Urban Heritage as an Economic Asset" and "Planning of the Heritage City of Kandy" were the main themes of the training programmes. A committee of National Trust experts has been appointed to give advisory support to complement the special project, on the Jaffna Medieval Grid City and development plans for other ancient Fortifications in the North and East-The other Projects undertaken during the year was to continue the development of the WEBSITE and the **Promotion of Modern Arts**.

The achievements of the National Trust during the year 2015 also have been mainly due to the team spirit and strong commitment and dedication of the Trustees, the members of the Management Committee, the Members of the Scientific and other Sub-Committees, the general membership and the well-wishers. The commitment and the enthusiasm exhibited by the team of volunteers who were with the Trust through-out has to be greatly appreciated. Let us take this opportunity to thank them all.

Hoping to see another successful year of operations during 2016, let me conclude my report for the year 2015.

#### 1. Information of National Trust – Sri Lanka

#### 1.1 General

The National Trust – Sri Lanka was founded on the 27<sup>th</sup> of May 2005. Being an Association not for gain, the Minister of Justice, by his Order made under Section 114 of the Trust Ordinance and published in the Government Gazette Extraordinary No. 1575 / 26 dated 14<sup>th</sup> November 2008, declared the trust, a body corporate with perpetual succession.

#### 1.2 Principle Activities and Nature of operations

The objects of the Trust are protecting and safeguarding the tangible and intangible cultural and natural heritage of Sri Lanka including sites, monuments, sculptures, paintings, artifacts, music, dance, the fauna and flora of Sri Lanka.

#### 2. Summary Of Significant Accounting Policies

2.1 General Policies

#### 2.1.1 Basis of Preparation

The Statement of Financial Position and Statement of Financial Activities together with Notes, ("Accounts") of the Trust as at 31 December 2015 and for the year then ended, comply with the Accounting Policies and Notes of the Trust.

These Accounts presented in Sri Lanka Rupees have been prepared on a historical cost basis.

#### 2.1.2 Comparative Information

The accounting policies have been consistently applied and are consistent with those used in the previous year.

#### 2.1.3 Income Tax

Income tax is provided in accordance with the provisions of the Inland Revenue Act No. 10 of 2006, on the profits earned by the Trust and is based on the elements of income and expenditure reflected in the Statement of Financial Activities.

#### 2.1.4 Inventories

Inventories have been valued at their actual cost.

#### 2.1.5 Trade and Other Receivables

Receivables are stated at the amounts they are estimated to realize.

#### 2.1.6 Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and Cash equivalents comprise cash in hand and demand deposits together with short term, highly liquid investments, readily convertible to known amounts of each and are subject to an insignificant risk of changes in value.

2.1.7 Property, Plant and Equipment

a) Cost

Property, Plant and Equipment are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation.

#### b) Depreciation

The provision for depreciation is calculated by using a straight line method on the cost or valuation of all Property and Equipment other than Land, in order to write off such amounts over the estimated useful lives by equal installments as follows;

Depreciation is computed on straight line basis.

#### 2.1.8 Liabilities

All known liabilities as at the Statement of Financial Position date are included in the Accounts.

#### 2.1.9 Revenue Recognition

Income is recognized in the accounting period in which the income is earned.

#### 2.1.10 Expenditure Recognition

Expenses in carrying out the activities of the Trust are recognized in the Statement of Financial Activities during the period in which they are incurred. Other expenses incurred in administering and running the Trust are accounted for on an accrual basis and charged to the Statement of Financial Activities.
